Why HOMELINK needs you

HOMELINK helps local homeless people of all faiths and none. It works by offering an interest-free loan (repayable in easy stages) for part or all of the money they need to obtain accommodation. We also offer one-off grants to buy essential items for a new home, and for emergency accommodation for ex-offenders from HMP Lewes who have nowhere to go on release

Applicants for housing loans - people for whom Lewes District Council has no statutory liability - are referred to HOMELINK by the Council, and are looking for private-sector housing to rent in Lewes District or further afield in Sussex.

The number of applications for loans is increasing, and the cost of each is rising. The average loan now costs us £1,516, a total in 2018 of over £144,000. So HOMELINK really needs your help and support.

Did you know?

HOMELINK enabled 86 tenancies in 2016 and another 103 in 2017 and 95 in 2018

HOMELINK also works in association with Sussex Pathways to assist mentored ex-offenders

We rely on support from local churches, local groups, and individuals, who give regularly or organise events and collections for HOMELINK. But there are other ways you can help if you will:
